Thank you for your email of 24 June 2024 seeking the following information:

"Can you advise whether CCC has been advised by NZTA if it intends to quantify the forecast emissions impact of the 2024-2027 RLTP's and NLTP?"

The Commission has considered your request in accordance with the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act).

Response

We have interpreted "RLTP's and NLTP" in your request to be Regional Land Transport Plans and the National Land Transport Plan.

In response to your request, we are able to advise that we have not been able to find any information to confirm whether the Climate Change Commission was advised by the New Zealand Transport Agency (NZTA) if they intend to quantify the forecast emissions impact of the 2024-2027 Regional Land Transport Plans and the National Land Transport Plan.

In preparing this response, we consulted with Commission staff who most likely would have received said advice from NZTA. All staff consulted with confirmed that no such advice was received.

As such, we are unable to provide you with the information you seek as it does not exist. We rely on section <u>18(e) of the Act</u> to support our decision.
